Kojun Sato started playing the saxophone in the early 1990's while he was a student at Wako University in Tokyo. During this period due to the loss of his sight, he made the decision to step more into a more serious music world, and started taking lessons from Lew Tabakin shortly after his graduation. Upon the completion of few years of rehabilitation and general preparations, he was accepted to the Oberlin Conservatory of Music in the fall of 1999, where he studied with Gary Bartz. He received a Bachelor of Music degree from the same institution in May 2004, and is currently working on his Masters degree at the Mason Gross School of Art at Rutgers University, studying with Ralph Bowen. He currently lives in New York City and is playing various live performances and jam sessions.
